# Sample DCPO Job Description

Title: Designated Child Protection Officer (DCPO)

**Supervisor:** Executive Director

**Duration:** One year commitment minimum

**Time Commitment:** On call full-time, available to receive calls and respond to incidents or

concerns of child well-being.

**Description of assignment:** The DCPO is the "go-to" person for all child safety and protection concerns.

**Outcomes and goals:** To the best of their ability, the DCPO will ensure the highest child safety and protection standards are in place, leading to a safer community for children and youth to grow and thrive.

### Responsibilities and tasks:

Pass a background check.

- Submit a completed application, including two (non-related) references.
- Respond to all calls or other inquiries relating to child safety and protection concerns immediately upon notification.
- Relay all instances of disclosed or suspected child abuse to the appropriate authorities, and the Executive Director immediately.
- Oversee the planning and execution of child safety and protection standards and procedures outlined in the Child Protection Policy.

### **Desired qualifications:**

- A passion for seeing children and youth live life to its fullest.
- A commitment to take every step necessary to ensure the safety and protection of children and youth participants.
- Available and willing to respond to inquiries and concerns relating to child safety and protection 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Approachable, trustworthy, reliable and friendly.

## Training and support plan:

The DCPO will receive training/certification in the following **prior** to taking on their role and responsibilities:

- CPR certification
- Recognizing and responding to child abuse
- Emergency preparedness
- Disaster response

- Transporting children safely
- Creative behavior management
- Positive discipline
- Conflict resolution
