- The 2012 season marks the $17^{\text {th }}$ annual edition of the World Vision Gift Catalog.
- The Gift Catalog started in 1996.
- More than 100 meaningful gifts ranging in price from $\$ 16$ to $\$ 39,000$ are contained in the catalog.
- There are more than 250 items online at www.worldvisiongifts.org.
- Last year more than 350,000 animals were distributed. Goats continue to be the most popular animal to give. Last year, more than 67,000 goats were purchased by donors. Other popular gifts include: sheep, chickens, soccer balls, ducks, and an education for a child.
- Last year more than 160,000 donors purchased more than 490,000 items that raised over $\$ 33$ million. These items help more than 825,000 people around the world.*
- More than 30 gifts in the catalog are $\$ 35$ or less, including items like chickens, job training, or fruit trees.
- In 2011, 86 percent of World Vision's total operating expenses were used for programs that benefit children, families, and communities in need.
